TO KNOW/LEARN Ensure you have life saving equipment for the whole crew How to swim, row and paddle Check you have first aid supplies and medicine How to wear the life jacket and give first aid Check the fire fighting equipment How to drive/sail your boat Secure all loose items properly How to move in the boat and how to balance it How to make the basic knots, even in the dark 3. AT THE SEA How to take care and use the ropes Always wear life jackets How to moor and anchor securily and safely Follow the weather How to use the charts, compass and other Follow the marine traffic rules navigation equipment and how to navigate Be aware of your location and The marine traffic rules and navigation marks water depth at all times Acknowledge your impact to the marine wildlife Be prepared to assist other boaters in need and environment 2. BEFORE THE SAILING TRIP 4. WHEN ARRIVING TO PORT Lower your speed so that you are not disturbing Ensure the boat is seaworthy for the planned trip or harming others Ensure the crew is proper and sufficiently When under sail, lower the sails well before trained for the trip entering the port and use engine to approach Check the fresh water supply Prepare enough fenders for mooring Plan and buy the food supplies Assist arriving boats with berth selection and Check the engine and fuel supply mooring, there is always room for another boat Empty septic waste tank Check that you have all the needed charts and equipment for navigation
